



Table No. 2: Applicability / Relevance to red life situation.





Table No. 4: Extent of coverage of course









From the analysis of responses it is revealed that maximum. 32 (42.02%) respondents opined that course content is highly relevant for future





Table No. 9: Opinion about the library holdings for the course.


