Student Satisfaction Survey

In this academic year 437 students admitted in B.A. & B.Com programme out of these 437 students, 100 students were selected for SSS by random method. Special care has been taken to give representation to all classes. Questionnaires were distributed among selected students, the responses to SSS were analyzed and the findings of the survey are as follows.

- 1) From the analysis of responses it is found that out of 100 respondents maximum that is 75 (75%) opined that, more than 85% syllabus covered by the teachers in the class where as 20% respondents by teachers in the class. Hence from the survey it is revealed that teachers completed almost all syllabus prescribed by the affiliated university.
- 2) From the survey it is observed that maximum that is 85% student's states that teachers prepared thoroughly before teaching in class room.
- 3) From the students satisfaction study it is observed that maximum students that is 80% are of opinion that communication skill of teachers in class is always very effective.
- 4) Study of students responses indicate that maximum that is 70% students are of the opinion that teachers approach towards teaching is excellent where as 20% students states that teachers approach is very good and remaining 10%

students state that teachers approach is good hence from the analysis it is revealed that teachers approach to teaching is excellent.

- 5) From the survey it is revealed that majority of students i.e. 80% opined that internal evaluation process is always fair whereas 18% said that is usually fair.
- 6) From the analysis of responses it is observed that 74% students state that performance in assessment is discuss every time where as 18% state that discussion on assessment in class is usually conducted.
- 7) There are B.A.,B.Com courses in college and internship, student exchange and field visit is not a part of syllabus. Though collage arrange excursion tour, field visit to historical places, industry etc. In response to institute take active interest in promoting internship, students exchange field visit maximum students i.e. 85% record their opinion as college often arrange these activity.
- 8) The survey revealed that maximum that is 70% respondent are of the opinion that collage significantly work in teaching and mentoring process which facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
- 9) From the analysis of responses related to institution provided multiple opportunities to learn and grow it is observed that 45% respondent strongly agree with the statement whereas 35% agree with the statement
- 10) From the survey it is observed that maximum i.e. 75% respondent state that teachers informed them about course outcomes, program outcomes and the expected competencies after completion of program.

- 11) From the survey it is revealed that maximum i.e. 78% students opined that through ' Maze Guru Maze Ghari ' (mentor - mentee scheme) mentor regularly take follow up with assigned task and discussed with mentee on their problem.
- 12) Maximum i.e. 74% respondent state that teachers while teaching in classroom every time illustrate the concept through examples & applications.
- 13) The analysis regarding "teachers identify strengths and encourage students" it is observed that majority of students (75%) are fully agree with above statement.
- 14) The survey reveals that maximum i.e. 70% students are of opinion that teachers every time identified their weakness and help them to overcome
- 15) The survey reveals that 72% respondents are strongly agree with "The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous qualities improvement of the teaching learning process.
- 16) From the survey it is observed that 65% responded are of the opinion that teachers to a great extent use student centric method while teaching learning whereas 24% respondent states that student centric teaching learning process is at moderate level.
- 17) From the survey it is found 78% respondents are strongly agree with teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.
- 18) The analysis of responses regarding "institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skill" indicate that 54% responded state that institute work in this area to a great extent where as sizable no of i.e.

20% and 18% respectively state that work is moderate and some what hence there is scope for improvement in this area.

- 19) From the study it is found that 83% respondent state that above 90% teachers use ICT tools in the teaching learning process.
- 20) From the survey it is found that maximum that is 85% respondent opined that they are strongly agree with quality of teaching learning process is very good.
